This Week's Math and Science Standards / Test Dates

This week in Math, students will continue with Topic 1: Multiplication and Division: Meanings and Facts. Students will be reviewing multiplication and division and exploring the ways they are related by using fact families. A fact family is made up of multiplication and division facts that include all the same numbers. Use the example below to help your child develop her or his understanding of fact families.

In Science, students will complete Chapter 1: Living Things Need Energy. In Chapter 1, your child has about the role of photosynthesis in capturing solar energy, how that energy is used in food chains and webs, and the roles of microorganisms. The Chapter 1 Science test will be Thursday. As a reminder, all Science tests are open-book, and your child is welcome to take his or her textbooks home to study from (as long as they are returned the following day)!
