## This Week's Math \& Social Studies Standards / Test Dates

In Math this week, your child will begin Topic 15: Solving Measurement and Data Problems. The students will learn how to find the area and perimeter of simple rectangular shapes, as well as how to solve problems involving money and line plots. The Topic 15 test will be Friday. Please note that this will be the LAST Math test with an opportunity for a retest! Following the Topic 15 test, students will begin their final Math topic, Topic 14: Measurement and Conversions. In Topic 14, the students will measure using units of length, capacity, and weight. I will be breaking Topic 14 into essentially two topics: first metric (worldwide) and then customary (U.S.A.) units and conversions.

In Social Studies, your child complete Chapter 8: A Growing Economy. The students will read about the rapid economic development in California in the late 1800's and early 1900's, and its effect on Californians. They will also learn how the great San Francisco earthquake and fires of 1906 leveled the city, as well as how the need for its rebuilding helped create many employment opportunities. Chapter 8 will be the last Social Studies test for the year! Students will move on to Science following Chapter 8, where they will learn about magnetism and electricity.
