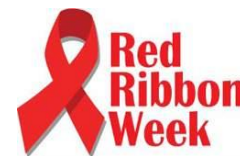

This Week's Math & Social Science Standards / Test Dates

In Math, students will continue with Topic 6: Fluency: Multiplying by 1-Digit Numbers. In Topic 6, your child will work on their fluency (mastery/speed) when multiplying 1-digit numbers, as well as how to check their answer's "reasonableness" by estimating. If your child has difficulty with his or her math facts, I highly recommend practicing at home for added fluency.

In Social Studies, your child will begin Chapter 3: Exploration and Early Settlements. In Chapter 3, the students will learn about the Spanish establishment of missions, presidios, and pueblos in Alta California, including the work of Junípero Serra. The open-book test will be next Tuesday.
