This Week's Math and Science Standards / Test Dates

In Math, the students will test on Topic 8: Developing Fluency: Multiplying by 2-Digit Numbers on Tuesday, then begin Topic 9: Number Sense: Dividing by 1-Digit Divisors this week. In Topic 9, your child will learn to divide numbers with and without remainders. An important part of this concept is understanding how to share items equally. Also, since division has such a close relationship with multiplication, I HIGHLY encourage students to practice any multiplication facts that they have not yet fully memorized. The test is next Thursday.

Students will continue with Chapter 3: Rocks and Minerals. In this chapter, your child will learn the various classification methods for rocks and minerals, and how and where different rocks and minerals are formed. The Chapter 3 test will be Friday.
