This Week's Math and Science Standards / Test Dates

In Math, we will review all concepts learned up through this point in the school year, including multi-digit addition, subtracting across zeros, multiplying using both standard and expanded form, and long division with remainders. The students will begin Topic 10 once we return from our Winter Break! ⁽ⁱ⁾ (Please note: there will be NO Math homework this week!)

In Science, we will complete Chapter 4: Slow Changes on Earth. In this chapter we will be learning about landforms and weathering, including erosion and deposition.
