## Dear Parents...

We have a big week ahead of us! To begin, our first field trip is this Tuesday, October $10^{\text {th }}$. Students should arrive by the regularly scheduled morning bell (8:45 a.m.) with a packed lunch. Please note that cell phones and cameras are acceptable for photographs/videos ONLY! Also, the kids will receive their FREE Kindness Conference T-shirt to change into once school starts. Parent volunteers, I will see you at 8:45 in Room 401 as well. ©

In other news, final grades for the first trimester are due! I gave students the opportunity of an extra day to complete retests and assignment makeups on Monday. The final day for A.R. points and percentages (counted toward the first trimester) will be Tuesday.

Language Arts will look very different over the course of the next three weeks as we dive into our first Core-Literature Unit, Because of WinnDixie. The students will be challenged with reading the entirety of a chapter book (2-3 chapters per day), and completing several related activities to connect with the story in a deeper and more meaningful way than with previous reading selections. The students' Language Arts homework will now include a journal reflection upon the main idea from the daily chapters. Students should restate the question and answer in 5-7 complete sentences.

If I do not hear from you by Wednesday, I will assign a day and time for your conference.

## This Week's Math \& Science Standards / Test Dates

In Math, your child will begin working on Topic 5: Number Sense: Multiplying by 1-Digit Numbers. In Topic 5 , your child will learn a variety of methods to multiply two-and-three-digit numbers by one-digit numbers. By looking for patterns in multiplication facts, he or she can also multiply multiples of 10 by one-digit numbers using mental math. These patterns also help your child estimate products by comparing the product to the estimate to see if an answer is reasonable. Once again, the students will be using the Rounding Rap in order to estimate their answers. The Topic 5 test scores will be the first math grades for Trimester 2.

In Science, we will complete Chapter 2: Living Things and Their Environment. In Chapter 2, students will learn that all living things are members of ecosystems. They learn that plants and animals depend upon each other for food and shelter, or for pollination and seed dispersion. Finally, students learn the effects that human activities can have on ecosystems and things that people can do to protect the world around them.
