Finally, next Tuesday is Halloween! #### This Week's Math & Science Standards / Test Dates

In Math, students will begin Topic 6: Fluency: Multiplying by 1-Digit Numbers. In Topic 6, your child will work on their fluency (mastery/speed) when multiplying 1-digit numbers, as well as how to check their answer's "reasonableness" by estimating. Your child has already learned a variety of multiplication games in class including "Multiplication Dice" and "Multiplication War." These games can be played with just a pair of dice or a deck of regular playing cards and a piece of paper (for keeping score, of course)! In the computer lab, they have worked with online programs such as www.multiplication.com and Math Magician (via the Oswego School District), as well as CNUSD software programs such as iReady and Moby Max (both of which can be accessed at home). If your child has difficulty with his or her math facts, I highly recommend using these resources at home for added fluency (and fun) in addition to practicing flash cards daily.

Due to our shortened schedule and daily time frame this week, we will NOT focus on Science or Social Studies. We will begin Chapter 3: Exploration and Early Settlements next Monday, however.
